Queen Elizabeth II – A Life of Duty

She received a good education at home and developed a strong sense of responsibility from an early age. During World War II, she even helped the country by working as a mechanic and driver.

She became queen in 1952, after the death of her father, King George VI. From that moment on, she dedicated her life to serving her country and the people of the United Kingdom. She travelled widely, met world leaders, and supported many charities and organizations throughout her reign.
